## This Week in Lanquage Arts

Teachers have been working diligently in the classrooms to balance instruction and testing. We will continue to test the students on their Guided Reading Level through Mclass.
We are continuing our class read of Stone Fox. We are looking at figurative language elements in the story such as similes, metaphors, onomatopoeias, hyperbole and personification. We will continue to analyze story elements such as character, plot and setting. We will also be focusing on characters, their traits and how they change throughout the story.

## This Week in Math

Students will be reviewing for their Unit 1 place value test on Monday. They will take their Unit 1 test on Tuesday 9/27 and we will begin our new unit of Geometry on Wednesday. In our Geometry unit we will be describing and categorizing shapes by their attributes (i.e. how many sides they have, what kind of angles, etc ...). We will also be covering perimeter. This Unit will last approximately two weeks.
