## Curriculum Corner

Writing- continuation of narrative writing...story endings and editing in preparation for final copies Language Arts/Social Studies- verbs- past, present and future tense, determining the main idea/details, using nonfiction text features to locate information, stopping and jotting while reading, referring back to the text to answer questions; community leadership roles

Math- using multiplication to divide w/2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9; multiplication patterns: even and odd numbers; division using 0 and 1; memorizing multiplication facts 0-10
